Who is the personalised route suitable for? It's for learners with significant practical teaching experience who wish to obtain SEQ qualifications.

- It's for learners who are not able to attend a course, and would like to fit the training in around their work and home life and their teaching commitments.
- It is even suitable for those of you who hold an 'old' ASA teaching qualification and would like to update it.

This programme is not suitable for you if you have no or limited teaching experience. In this case you will be recommended to complete the full course.

What is the personalised route?

- It is an accelerated programme to enable students to obtain the SEQ Level 1 Swimming Assistant (Teaching), SEQ Level 2 Teaching Swimming or SEQ Level 2 Teaching Swimming to Babies and Toddlers.
- This is achieved through a combination of distance or blended learning, without necessarily having to attend face-to-face training sessions.
- Training can be completed mostly at home and in your workplace.
- A tutor will be allocated to you to support, guide, and coach / mentor each learner through their programme.
- You will be responsible for managing your own work programme and submitting work to your tutor.

How does it work?

All learners are initially assessed with a RPL (recognition of prior learning) questionnaire to check their suitability for the personalised route. If your participation through this route is appropriate, and after we receive your fees, you will be accepted onto the training programme. You will then be required to submit documents and evidence to meet the standards required for the qualification. A personal tutor (assessor) will support you throughout the programme, and there may be others appointed from time to time to conduct part of the assessments.

The following methods of communication and assessment may be used according to circumstances:

- Visits to your workplace
- Practical teaching observations
- Theoretical question papers
- Skype / phone calls
- Face-to-face meeting, marking and assessment of portfolio.

In order to meet the requirements of the assessed units and outcomes, you will be required to complete practical teaching session plans/ coaching schedules as appropriate, written tasks including



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knowledge test papers, distance learning work, and other tasks as directed by your tutor. You will need to be teaching a range of abilities with classes of at least 8 swimmers.

It is important to note that Flexible Learning is not a short cut to gaining qualifications. Learners are assessed to the same criteria and standards as those who attend a formal taught course.

How much does it cost?

The price depends on the qualification(s) you wish take and already hold.

The initial package is fully inclusive of the following:

- Tutor's time for assessment, professional discussions, visits etc;
- Current SEQ registration fee;

Package prices are calculated based on expected tutor/assessment time. Any additional tutor time required would be charged at £50 per hour (pro-rotta);

- Practical visit – 1.5 hours;
- RPL, face to face and phone calls – 1 hour;
- Assessment – 1 hour
